#### **How to Vote**

Print out the ballot and mark **Yes** if you are in favor of the motion amending the Bylaws, or **No** if you are opposed. The motion is:

To amend section 5.1 of the Bylaws by striking the words "on a monthly basis," and to amend section 5.2 of the Bylaws by striking the word "October" and inserting "November."

# To Seal the Ballot

Fold the ballot, then seal it inside an envelope. Print your name on and sign the outside of the envelope. If the name on the envelope does not match the list of registered members, your vote will not be opened - so print clearly.

## To Vote at the Meeting

Bring your signed envelope to the meeting or have another person bring it for you and cast it before the polls close.

## To Vote by Mail

Place the signed envelope into another envelope and mail it to the WPLUG mailbox. When your letter is received, an e-mail confirmation will be sent to you from the Secretary or one of his designees. Your ballot must be received before the Meeting to be counted.
